USEFUL VACCINATION-RELATED INFORMATION

Vulnerable Peoples Homebound Vaccination Program (VPHVP) – Commonwealth

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The Vulnerable Peoples Homebound Vaccination Program is a Commonwealth Government initiative to provide vaccinations to vulnerable populations.

This program assists those who find it hard to leave their homes to be vaccinated and can assist people with COVID-19 vaccine doses 1, 2, 3 and winter doses.

‘Homebound’ may include but is not limited to:

- frail aged and elderly, people living with a disability or a mental health condition which prevents them from leaving their home.

Primary Health Networks (PHNs) – *Eastern Melbourne, North-Western and South-Eastern PHNs* have partnered to deliver the vaccination program to homebound clients within their specific regions.

The PHNs receive the referrals, manage the intake and refer on to a local vaccination provider.

Vaccination providers will contact the person (or their nominated contact) to schedule a time for the visit and undertake the relevant safety screening, before providing the service.

Clients will be able to receive 1st, 2nd doses and 3rd doses for immunocompromised people, as well as winter dose for those eligible.

Influenza vaccination can be co-administered when providing a COVID-19 vaccination.

All requests must be made on the referral link for clients to be scheduled for a visit.

To refer:

Each PHN has their own referral link, however if you are unsure which catchment someone is in and complete the incorrect referral form, they will be redirected to the appropriate PHN.

GP Respiratory Clinics

GP Respiratory Clinics are in place to clinically *assess, test and treat people with mild respiratory symptoms*, including COVID-19, influenza and asthma.

These clinics:

In the north-eastern region, such clinics are located at the following locations:

- **Banyule Respiratory Clinic – Heidelberg**
- **Broadmeadows Respiratory Clinic**

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- are for people that are unwell with mild respiratory symptoms (*such as coughing, runny nose, fever*) or other COVID-19 symptoms (*such as nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea*)
- offer face to face assessments (including testing) and immediate support for respiratory illnesses (*such as influenza, COVID-19, asthma, hay fever*)
- provide care for people with COVID-19, including via Telehealth (can be accessed even if you do not live close by to the clinic)
- are staffed by general practitioners and nurses
- are free for everyone (babies, children and adults), with or without a Medicare card.

Living with COVID-19 Home Visiting Program

This new program allows for COVID-19 positive patients to have a clinical face-to-face assessment, when the patient's

The service can be provided in the following LGA's:

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regular GP is unable to do so, or the person does not have a regular GP

The program:

- Will target all COVID-19 positive people living at home or in residential care, who need to have a clinical assessment face-to-face.
- Includes coverage in both daytime (9am to 5pm) and after-hours (5pm to 11.59pm) seven days a week.
- Is performed by GPs and nurses as clinically appropriate.

Eligibility criteria

- The person must live at home or in a RACF in the LGAs covered by the home visiting provider (refer to provided postcode list).
- Are COVID-19 positive or have tested positive for COVID within the past 30 days.
- Do not have a regular GP, or their GP does not have the capacity to provide a face-to-face visit.
- Require care or treatment of COVID-19 related symptoms and/or other care whilst needing to isolate.
- Are with or without a Medicare card.
