## Course Outline

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to a casualty in line with first aid guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies. The unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

## Entry Requirements

There is no specific entry requirement for this course. However, the Learner upon enrolment or before course commencement should inform the RTO if they have an identified language/literacy or other learning need, or a disability or have physical limitations, so that the assessment method can be “reasonably adjusted” by the RTO and pre-determined to best accommodate the Learner so that they will be able to appropriately work their way through the training program. Note that the Learner will need to meet the Foundation Skills requirements (language, literacy and numeracy) to successfully complete the course.

The Learners must have the physical capacity to perform the practical demonstrations, such as 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on the floor. Your certificate is valid for 3 years. You are required to refresh Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) within 12 months.

## Duration & Delivery Method

- Total hours: 18 (Classroom-based Training: 12 hours, Individual Learning Support (\*): 6 hours)
- Total Sessions: 2 (6 hours/session, from 9.00am to 3.30pm (including 30 minutes lunch break))
